Student Recruits Campus AAUW Partner: Rachel McDonald, sophomore at San Diego Mesa College and student affiliate member of the San Diego branch, recruited her campus as an AAUW college partner in December. She succeeded after a long 4-month process of networking with Pedro, president of Honors Club, of which Rachel is a member. Following discussions with many faculty, she joined the Associated Student Government (ASG). She subsequently was appointed to the San Diego Mesa College President's Cabinet. While serving on the President's Cabinet, Jesus, president of ASG, recommended that Rachel ask a Cabinet senator to write a bill asking for \$125 to fund the AAUW partnership fee. The bill was approved. Rachel contacted and convinced Dr. Ashanti Hands, Dean of Student Affairs, to represent AAUW on campus. Courtney Lee agreed to serve as a second college rep. Eureka! A check was sent to AAUW from the finance department to consummate the partnership.

Rachel is a unique student because most campuses are recruited as a college partner by local AAUW branch members. Rachel was determined that her campus join AAUW as a partner to enable students to enjoy the benefits as free e-student affiliates. aauw.org/student-member-join-renew
