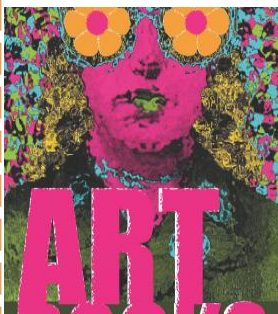

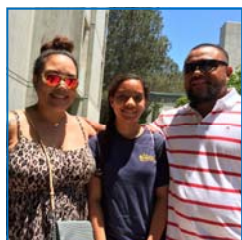
"Art Rocks the Boat" is an exploration of a large portion of the Women's Liberation Movement. Through historical research we can ascertain from whence we have come and where we are today.

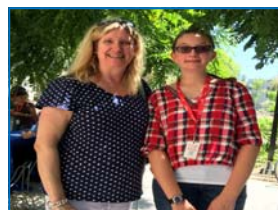
